



Current tech usage polarization among senior segments Daily internet activities on any device





Figure 6: Tech usage polarization among the five senior segments. Source: Ericsson ConsumerLab Analytical platform, Senior study, October 2019. Base: Online population aged 65-74 years within Canada, China, Germany, Italy, Japan, Sweden, UK, and US.







Solidarity is a practice by which people accept "costs" (financial, social, emotional, or otherwise) to support others with whom they see themselves as connected in some way

blue: practices grey: institutionalisation Solidarity during Covid-19




